Why Should I Choose To Be A Worshiper of YAHWEH?

1. Worship is an act of my will

“I will bless the Lord at all times; His **praise** shall continually be in my mouth. My soul will make its **boast** in the Lord; The humble will hear it and **rejoice**. O magnify the Lord with me, And let us **exalt** His name together.” Psalm 34:1-3 (NASB)

Six words for worship:

Bless – To favor Yahweh and give Him the worship He deserves

Praise – To commend, pay homage, and honor Yahweh with our lips

Boast – To brag about Yahweh’s attributes

Rejoice – To express our joy in Yahweh

Magnify – To rightly estimate the size and weight of Yahweh

Exalt – To lift Yahweh high and elevate Him to his rightful worth
